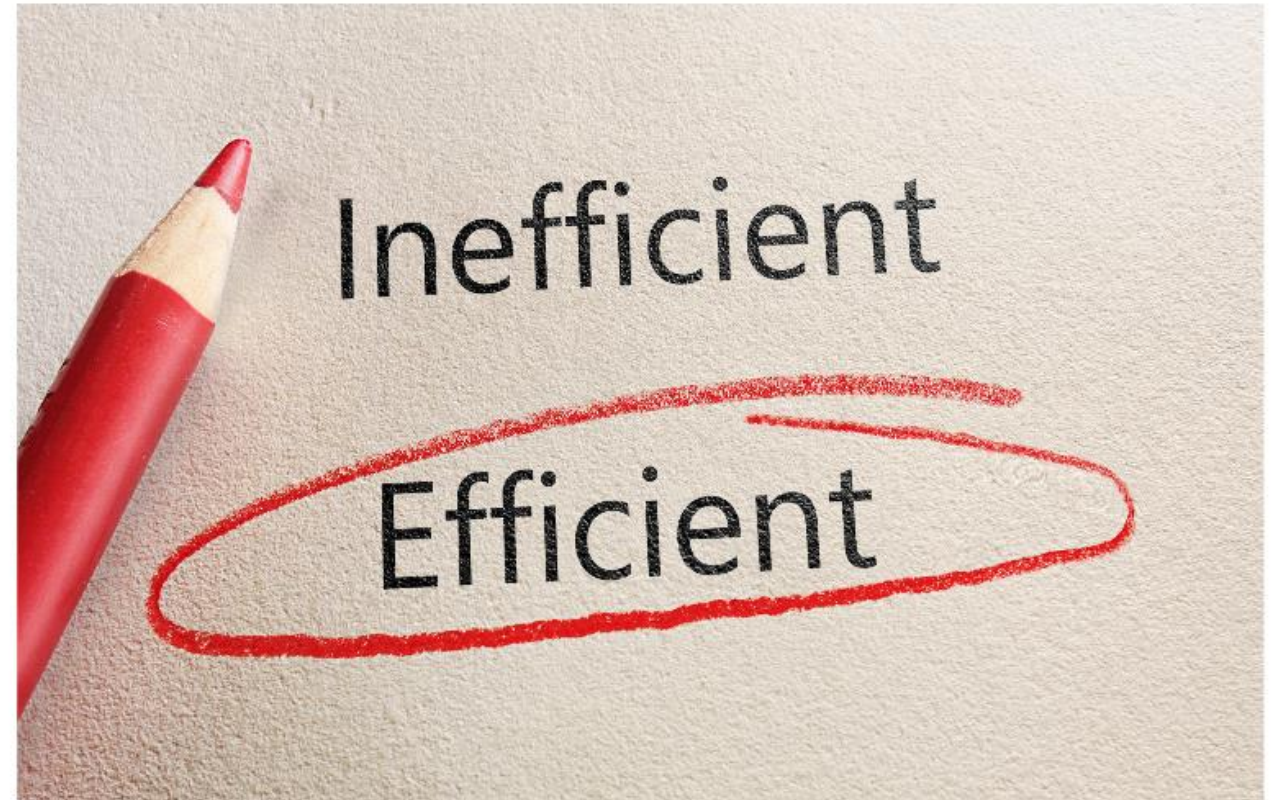
What is Continuous Improvement?

- Introduction of small incremental changes

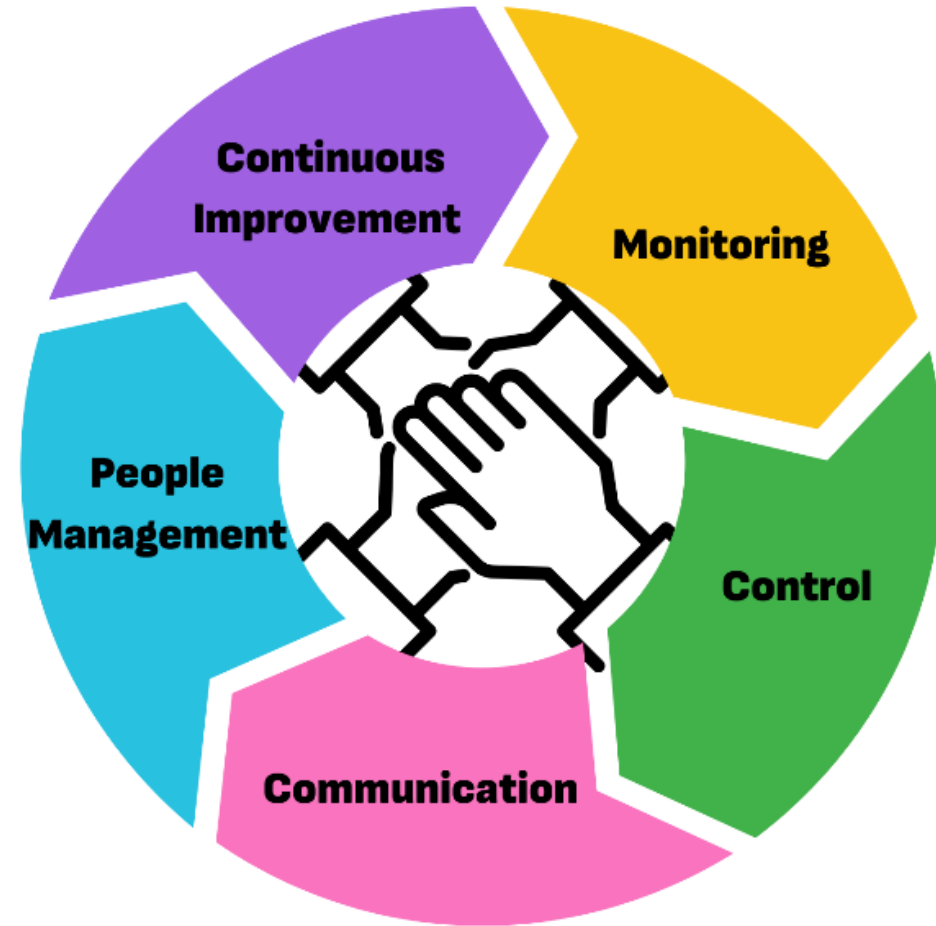


What is “waste” in Continuous Improvement?

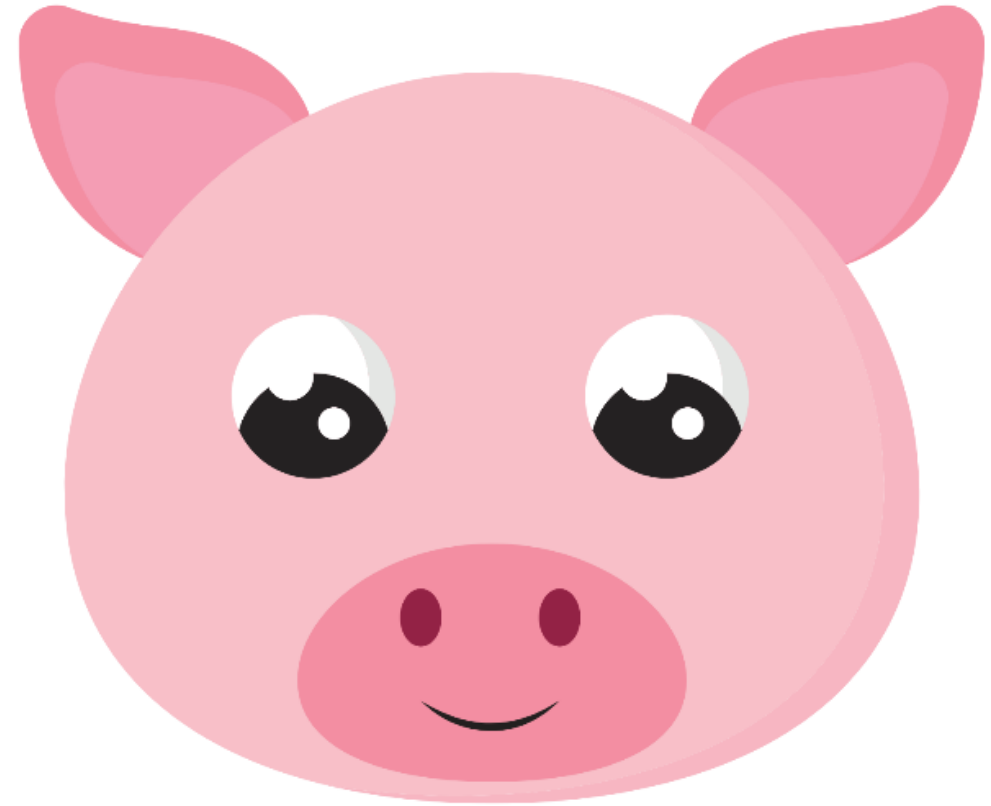
- A process that takes up time and effort but does not provide any customer benefit
