A challenging landscape

Major, long-term shifts in resourcing and demand are putting huge pressure on our services

Our customer base is growing, and customers have more complex needs

- Income tax customers have grown from 31 million in 2015-16 to 34 million in 2022-23
- Higher rate taxpayers increased by 22%
- Our advisors are dealing with longer, more complex enquiries
- Long-term reduction in tax gap
 - 56% by value attributed to small businesses

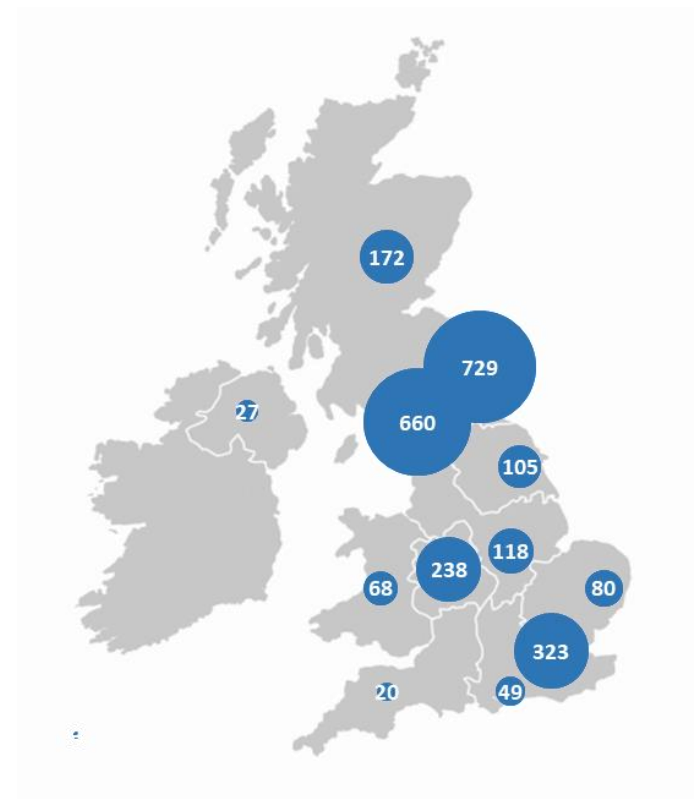

Currently, we are delivering over **37 programmes** and **c.100 projects** impacting on the UK population



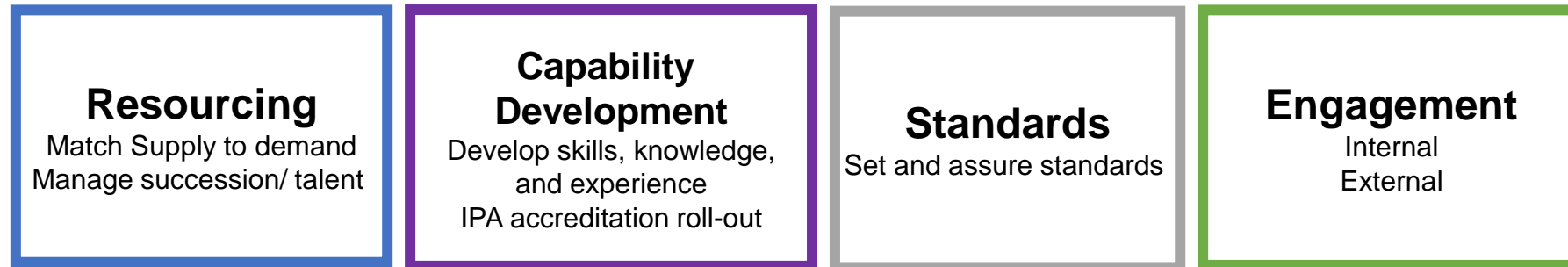

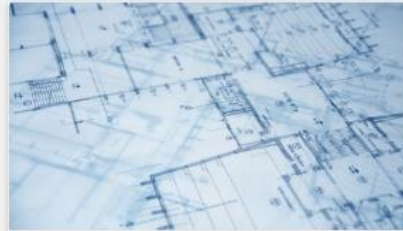
