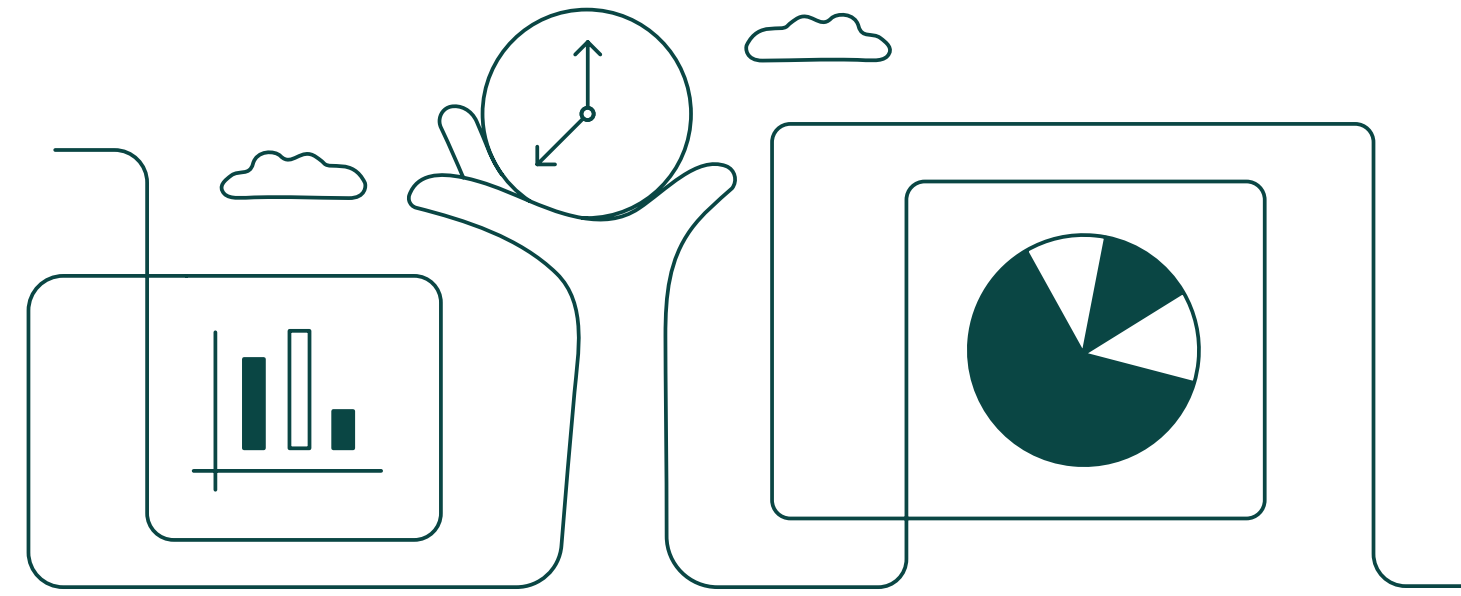

The APM Project Fundamentals Qualification is for those wishing to gain a broad understanding of the principles of the profession and the fundamentals of project management terminology.

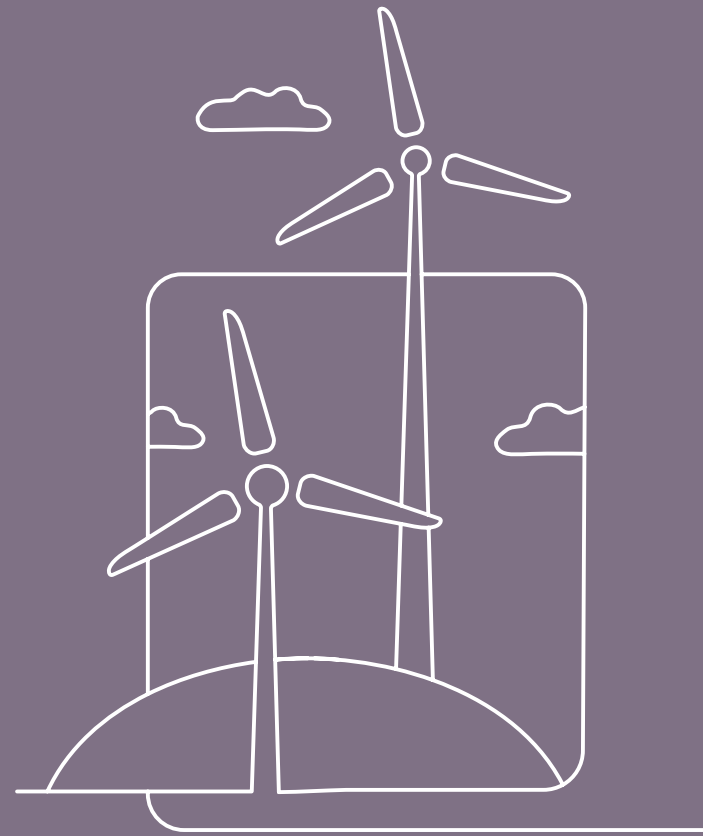
APM Project Management Qualification

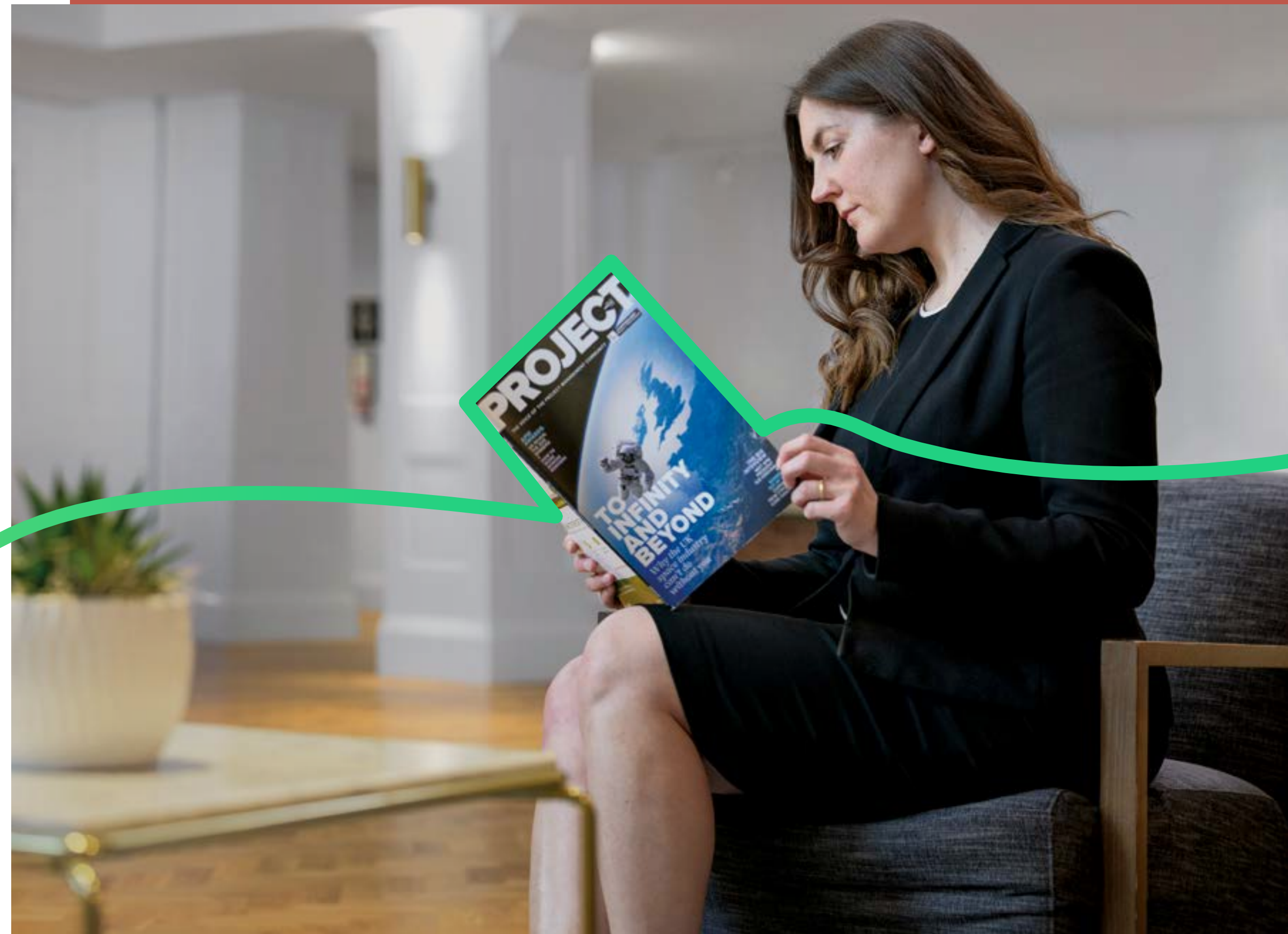

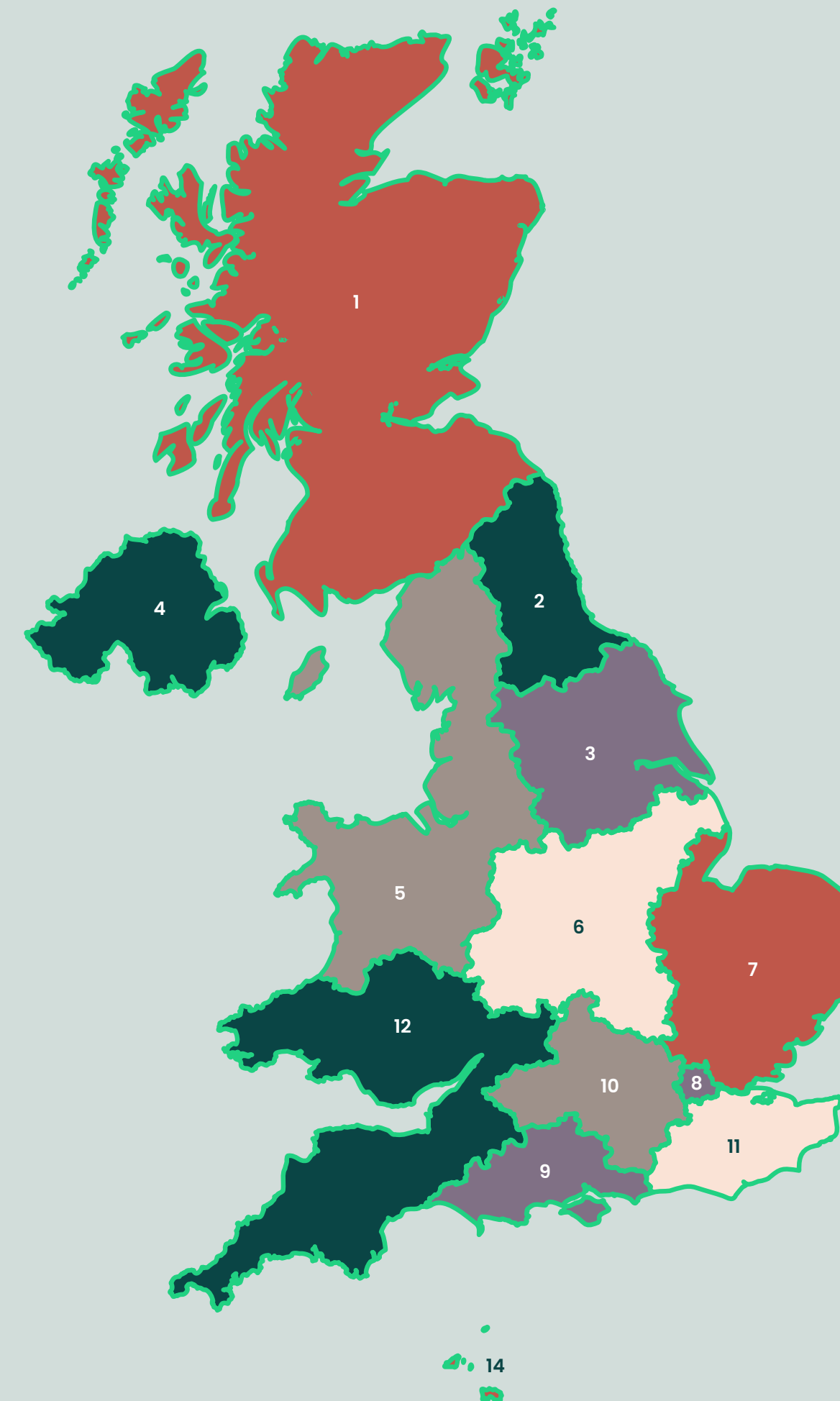
