

WAYNE WILSON AWARD FOR LIFETIME CONTRIBUTION IN PROJECT CONTROLS

Recognises the outstanding contribution and dedication to the Project Controls profession by an individual throughout their career. The judges are looking for a person who has made a lasting positive impact to the professional community and moved the community forward professionally.

DEPLOYMENT & VALUE (30%)

- Give an overview of the various key projects/programmes you/they participated in (including dates, duration, organisation and key outcomes that you/they directly influenced).
- Substantiate the value/benefits of your/their contribution, both internally and externally.
Up to 300 words

IMPACT (35%)

- Evidence how specific initiatives, you/they were directly involved with, have influenced & inspired others, including the breadth of impact these have had as a result. **Up to 400 words**

LEGACY (35%)

- Describe the achievements, contribution and lasting legacy to the profession during your/their professional career.
- Include key elements you/they would like the professional community to remember you/them for as well as any you/they already are credited with. **Up to 400 words**

There will be no discussions or interviews with applicants of the awards' submissions. Each written submission and documents are reviewed by a team of independent, professional, industry judges who will not confer on entries. Their decisions are final.
